SLIND was incorporated in the State of Tennessee on February 17, 2000. SLIND Submitted its HUBZone certification application and became certified by the Small Business Administration (SBA) on May 25, 2000. Following Certification the SBA conducted a program compliance examination on August 2001. This examination resulted in confirmation of a positive HUB Zone determination.

### Eligibility

A small business must meet all of the following criteria to qualify for the HUBZone program:

It must be located in a “historically underutilized business zone” or HUBZone.

It must be owned and controlled by one or more US Citizens, and

At least 35% of its employees must reside in a HUBZone.

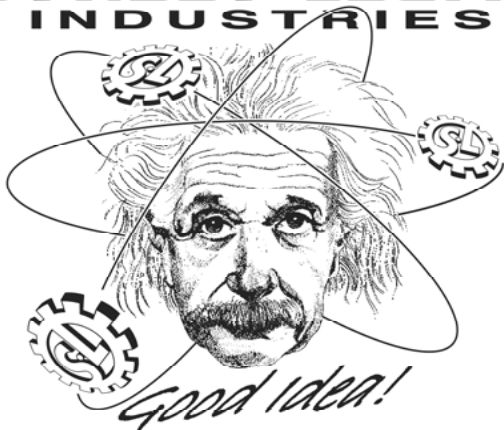
The HUBZone program has been institutionalized to stimulate economic development and create jobs in urban and rural communities by providing Federal contracting preferences. These preferences go to small businesses that obtain HUBZone certification in part by employing 35% of their staff who live in a HUBZone. The company must also maintain a "principal office" in one of these specially designated areas. Street Legal Industries, Inc. (SLIND) is an East Tennessee based HUBZone firm.
